

HAWAII WIC REFERRAL GUIDELINES

Eligible Categories

Women - pregnant, breastfeeding up to one year postpartum, non-breastfeeding up to 6 months postpartum

Infants - birth up to one year of age

Children - one year up to five years of age

Income Criteria: WIC applicants must meet income criteria for eligibility. WIC staff will make the income eligibility determination. Persons eligible for or receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Temporary Assistance for Other Needy Families (TAONF), State Child Health Insurance Program (S-CHIP), and Medicaid/QUEST benefits are **automatically** income eligible. For all others, the current income criteria is listed below.

Required Medical Data

- 1) **Height/Length** - The WIC office will measure height or length.
- 2) **Weight** - The WIC office will measure weight.
- 3) **Hemoglobin or Hematocrit (H/H)** - Referral H/H results taken within 90 days prior to WIC enrollment may be used if reflective of category and health status [women after start of pregnancy or after delivery, infants @ 9-12 months, and children @ 6 months after infant H/H and yearly thereafter]. The WIC office may perform a Hemoglobin test at the clinic. Applicants can be enrolled without blood test results if there is another nutritional risk, but the H/H results should be provided within 90 days of enrollment.
- 4) **Medical Diagnosis** - if available, such as the Expected Date of Delivery.

Other Required Data:

- 1) **Proof of Identification** - such as a drivers license or birth certificate.
- 2) **Proof of Residency** - such as a current utility bill, rent/mortgage receipts, or enrollment in a state program.

Referral Procedure

Referrals may be made using a WIC Referral form or in any format which provides all of the required information. Please provide the applicants' names, parent or guardian name, address, phone number, and relevant medical data. Referrals may be faxed to the nearest WIC office or to the WIC Services Branch Office. If faxing is not feasible, please have the applicant hand carry the application to the WIC local agency. Applications may be mailed if necessary.

All sources of referrals, including self referrals, will be accepted.
